



Spectators Code of Conduct

We are pleased to welcome you today to JSerra Catholic High School. Good sportsmanship is one of the primary purposes of educational athletics. Guidelines to good sportsmanship are as follows:

- Student – athletes must recognize that judgment calls – by coaches, officials, and themselves – are made in good faith and should be respected.
- Spectators should exercise great sportsmanship and six core principles: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and good citizenship.
- No taunting players, coaches, or officials.
- No person should use words or actions that could provoke a (violent) response
- No person shall intimidate or threaten another person
- Spectators can support their team by cheering in a positive manner.

- Spectators can support both teams by refraining from derogatory or demeaning comments or cheers today.
- Failure to adhere to the above will result in the spectator being asked to leave the JSCHS Athletic Facility.
